It is a statement that, obviously, if time is your invention, and it is the opposite of eternity, that time is not real. Right. Does everybody agree?

Now, the closest you can get to knowing time is not real would be a moment, wouldn't it? Doing what? Bringing your cause and your effect together. This moment, then. Is this moment what eternity is? It is as close as you can get to it. How about this moment? How about this one? Well, what moment isn't as close to eternity as you can get? None! Are all moments the same? Yes. There is only one.

the moments that you have structured in your thought form associations? Sure. Is it necessary for you to block off in your mind conceptual associations that have held you in the travesty of your own death association? Sure. That's the holy instants. Are they accumulating in you in the maturation of your body/mind association? Sure. That's the Course in Enlightenment.
